1. Vision:

- Legal Aid Clinic to give valuable suggestions to students / alumni/women workers regarding legal matters and to provide awareness of Women's Rights and Laws.
- To create a society with women working as equal partners in all spheres of life.
- To develop a framework to ensure equal rights and opportunities for women.
- To keep health and hygiene of women on priority.
- To address all forms of violence against women.
- To provide support from "Women to Women."
- To enable safety and security of women with the help of surveillance mechanisms in the College.
- Aiding women in workplace through maternity leave and provision of child care.
- To cultivate the feelings and responsibility to serve the society and nation.
- To organize different extension activities as Blood Donation, Plantation, Nukkad Nataks, Workshops, Human Chains, Poster Competitions, Rallies for awareness for different social issues etc.
- To create an awareness to prevent Infanticide and Foeticide.
- To distribute creative and required material on Women Empowerment.

- To prevent the misuse of "Women Rights."
- To enhance their knowledge, skill, strength and overcoming all their fears and weaknesses.
- To promote women's economic and gender equality.

- To ensure the health and hygiene of girls through health camps.

- To explore and enhance their skills in chosen fields.
- To make them self sufficient to furnish their own business and to offer jobs in the society.
- To arrange the fun fair in the college under the scheme of 'Earn While You Learn' and give the opportunity and platform to the students' business enterprise and managerial skills.
- To organize seminars, workshops and lectures with the help of experts from Industry sector for students, in this way the College establishes its interaction with industry.
- To start training programs such as Food Preservation, Fashion Designing, Accounting and Tally, Beauty Parlor, Boutique, assembling and repairing of electronics, Bakery, Bonsai Cultivation, Mural and Landscaping etc.
